- The IQAC will meet regularly (Bi-annually) to discuss quality-related matters.

Formation:

- The College Principal has nominated members based on their expertise and commitment to quality.
- The nominated members have been approved by the Governing Body.
- The Chairperson has appointed a committee secretary responsible for recording minutes and preparing reports.
- The IQAC will develop an annual action plan outlining its specific goals and activities.

Methodology:

The IQAC will adopt a multifaceted approach to quality assurance, including:

- Self-assessment: Conducting regular internal audits and reviews of academic and clinical programs, infrastructure, faculty performance, student feedback, and patient outcomes.
- Peer review: Inviting external experts to evaluate specific programs or processes and provide recommendations for improvement.
- Benchmarking: Comparing the College's performance with other similar institutions and international standards.
- Data analysis: Using data from various sources to identify trends, strengths, and weaknesses.
- Action planning: Developing and implementing action plans based on identified areas for improvement.
- Documentation and reporting: Maintaining records of all quality assurance activities and reporting findings and recommendations to the College Administration and Governing Body.




