### 1. Composition:

### 2. Responsibilities:

- Develop and implement a pharmacovigilance program for the college.
- Receive, review, and document all suspected adverse reactions (SARs) to homoeopathic medicines reported by students, faculty, or patients.
- Assess the causality of SARs and classify their severity.
- Report serious SARs to the national regulatory authority within the stipulated timeframe.
- Maintain records of all SARs and provide periodic reports to the college administration and regulatory authorities.
- Conduct pharmacovigilance training programs for students and faculty.
- Collaborate with other homoeopathic colleges and research institutions on pharmacovigilance activities.

### 3. Meetings:

- The PvC should meet at least six monthly to review SARs and discuss pharmacovigilance activities.
- Additional meetings may be convened as needed to address urgent matters.
- Minutes of each meeting should be documented and maintained for future reference.
